

ORDINANCE NO 10B

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE BOATING UPON THE WATERS OF
THE TOWN OF WOLF RIVER AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS

The Town Board of the Town of Wolf River, Winnebago County, Wisconsin do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Intent. The intent of this Ordinance is to provide safe and healthful conditions for the enjoyment of aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interests, and the capability of the water resources.

SECTION 2. State Boating and Safety Laws Adopted. State boating laws as found in Sections 30.50 to 30.71, Wisconsin Statutes, are adopted by reference.

SECTION 3. Applicability and Enforcement. The provisions of this Ordinance shall apply to those portions of the waters of the Wolf River hereinafter designated within the jurisdiction of the Town of Wolf River. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be enforced as provided in Wisconsin Statutes applicable under Sections 30.66, 30.68, 30.74, 30.745, and 30.77 by any law enforcement officer as defined under Wisconsin Statute Section 23.51(3) or 939.22(22). The primary law enforcement agency shall be the Winnebago County Sheriff's Office which shall respond to complaints directed to that department.

SECTION 4. Definitions. In this Ordinance:

(1) "Boat" means every description of watercraft used or capable of being used as a means of transportation on water.

(2) "Motorboat" means any boat equipped with propulsion machinery, whether or not the machinery is the principal source of propulsion.

(3) "Operation of Motorboat" means controlling the speed or direction of the motorboat.

(4) "Operator" means a person who is engaged in the operation of a motorboat, who is responsible for the operation of a motorboat, or supervising the operation of a motorboat.

(5) "Slow-no-wake" means that speed at which a boat moves as slowly as possible while maintaining steerage control.

(6) "Holiday" means Memorial Day, 4th of July and Labor Day.

SECTION 5. Controlled Area. No person shall operate a boat faster than slow-no-wake in the following described portions of the waters of the Town of Wolf River between the hours of 12:01 AM Saturday to 12:00 Midnight Sunday and holidays from 12:01 AM to 12 midnight:

(1). In the cut-off (Government Channel) between the south or Poygan end (GPS Coordinates N44° 10.147', W88° 47.062') and the north or River end (GPS Coordinates N44° 10.771', W88° 48.065').

(2). On the Rat River from approximately 100 yards east of Kiesow's Landing (GPS Coordinates N44° 11.393', W88° 46.878') to approximately 100 yards west of Kiesow's Landing (GPS Coordinates N44° 11.423', W88° 46.989').

(3). On the Wolf River from Lenz Point (GPS Coordinates N44° 10.416', W88° 48.868') to Page's Slough (GPS Coordinates N44° 10.572', W88° 48.790).

(4). On the Wolf River from Naparalla's Ditch (GPS Coordinates N44° 12.615', W88° 49.570') to the north end of the Triangle Farms Campground boat ramp (GPS Coordinates N44° 13.638', W88° 50.440').

SECTION 6. Posting Requirements. The Town of Wolf River shall place and maintain a synopsis of this Ordinance at all public access points within the jurisdiction of the Town pursuant to the requirements of NR 5.15 Wis. Admin. Code.

SECTION 7. Penalties. Wisconsin State boating penalties as found in Wisconsin Statute Section 30.80, and deposits as established in the Uniform Deposit and Bail Schedule established by the Wisconsin Judicial Conference, are hereby adopted by reference and all references to fines amended to forfeitures and all references to imprisonment deleted.

SECTION 8. Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Town Board would have passed the other provisions of this Ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid. If any provision of this Ordinance or the application to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of the Ordinance and the applications of such provisions to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected.

SECTION 9. Effective Date. This Ordinance will become effective upon passage and publication as provided by law.
